

# CGC Run Through Practice Test

Test Description	Pass	Needs Training	Comments
<b>1. Accepting a Friendly Stranger</b> <i>Evaluator approaches, shakes hands with handler. Does not touch dog.</i>			
<b>2. Sitting Politely for Petting</b> <i>Evaluator pets dog, dog must show no shyness or resentment</i>			
<b>3. Appearance and Grooming</b> <i>Evaluator inspects dog, combs or brushes lightly, examines ears and each front foot..</i>			
<b>4. Out for a Walk</b> <i>Handler takes dog for a short walk including right turn, left turn, about turn and stop.</i>			
<b>5. Walking Through a Crowd</b> <i>Dog and handler walk close to several people; dog may show casual interest but not jump up.</i>			
<b>6. Sit and Down on Command/Staying in Place</b> <i>Handler shows dog can do sit and down, then chooses a position, leaves dog and walks out 20 ft. and returns immediately. A 20ft. lead is optional.</i>			
<b>7. Coming When Called</b> <i>Handler walks out 10ft and calls the dog</i>			
<b>8. Reaction to Another Dog</b> <i>Two handlers and dogs approach, shake hands, exchange pleasantries, move on. Dogs can show casual interest.</i>			
<b>9. Reaction to Distractions</b> <i>Distractions are presented dog may not panic or show aggression</i>			
<b>10. Supervised Separation</b> <i>Handler goes out of sight for 3 minutes. Dog is held on 6 ft leash by an evaluator.</i>
