Entries limited to 60 runs. Green flat ribbons will be awarded to qualifiers. Course size is 62.5'x105' with crating on one side and 3 walls; surface is Comfort King matting. See trial premium for more details.

ACT will start after the Novice/Open trial in the building. Information on crating and tentative show time will be emailed prior to July 20.

All rounds are Standard courses. Running order: ACT1 Round 1, ACT1 Round 2, ACT2 Round 1, ACT2 Round 2.

You may enter the jump height of your choice: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, or 24 inches.

If your dog is entered in ACT1 and you didn't submit an entry for ACT2, you may enter ACT2 (if runs are available) on site before the ACT2 course walk-thru, at \$15/run.

The Agility Course Test (ACT) is an entry-level agility event designed to introduce beginning dogs and handlers to the sport of agility. Any dog that has not earned an AKC agility title (except ACT1) is eligible. Visit the <u>AKC ACT webpage</u> <u>https://www.akc.org/sports/agility/act-program/</u> for more information.

Dogs must be 15 months or older and meet the requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3), except that they do not need to be registered with AKC. Dogs that are not AKC registered may participate and their performance will be recorded by the AKC under a temporary recording number. This temporary number will be emailed to the owner and must be used when entering subsequent ACT events; it may not be used for other AKC events.
