### Directions to TD Headquarters Kennekuk County Park near Danville, IL.

From east or west on I-74 take exit #120. Turn right on Martin Luther King Drive (Rt. 150) and go to the first traffic light (Henning Road). Turn left (north) approximately four miles to the park entrance on the west side of the road. Meet at the Red Barn parking lot.

### Directions to TDX Headquarters Middle Fork River Forest Preserve near Penfield, IL.

Interstate I-57 to Exit #250 (US 136). Follow Rt. 136 east to County Road #22 (approximately 13 miles). Turn left (north) on County Road #22 and continue approximately 4.5 miles to entrance to Middle Fork Forest Preserve. Follow entrance road to first open air pavilion on your left.

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from I-74 take exit #197 (County Road #22) north for approximately 20 miles to entrance to Middle Fork Forest Preserve. Follow entrance road to first open air pavilion on your left.

## GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

1. Completion of entries. Make check or money order payable to: DTCCU. Mail check, entry form (on enclosed AKC Form or facsimile) and certification (where applicable) to: Ruth M/ Vogel, 15638 N Misty Lane, Effingham, IL 62401. Entries will not be accepted without signature and entry fee(s).
2. Bitches in season. Bitches in season MAY participate provided that the test secretary and judges are notified of same prior to the drawing of tracks. The last regular track(s) laid shall be for the bitch(es) in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held. Bitches in season will be allowed to participate in a test only after all the other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested.
3. Drawing for entry acceptance. A drawing will be held at The Dog Training Club of Champaign-Urbana training building, 2210 E Ford Harris Rd, Urbana, IL on Friday, September 20, 2024 at 7:00 pm to determine which entrants will participate in the Test and the position of excess entrants on the Alternate List. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks will be exchanged up to the limit set by the AKC Tracking Regulations. All entrants will be advised via email of the results of the draw.
4. Drawing for Running Order. Running order will be drawn by lot at 8:00 A.M. for TD and for TDX tracks at 10:00 am. On the day of the test at Sugar Creek Shelter, Middle Fork River Forest Preserve, Penfield, IL Entrants and alternates must be present at this drawing to guarantee their participation in the Test. The first tracks will be run immediately following the draw.
5. Refunds. Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the Alternate List. Also, entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the Test will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the Test Day unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.
6. Hospitality. Coffee, hot tea and water will be available at Sugar Creek Shelter before the draws. A “dutch treat” luncheon will be held at a local restaurant after the TDX judging.

## AGREEMENT

I(we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

## INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. Over 13 in. But not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wire-haired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, Miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
