Consult judging program for time of judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Dogs must be present only for scheduled time of judging. Dogs may be removed immediately after judging, unless required for further judging.

Trial 1 Choice will start with the 10-minute walk-thru at 8:20 AM each day followed by Master, Excellent A/B, Advanced A/B, Intermediate, and Novice A/B.

Trial 2 Choice begins after the conclusion of Trial 1 following the same class order progression.

Dog means either sex. A qualifying score is required for all prizes in the Regular Classes. All awards will be made at the trial. No trophies will be mailed. Junior Handlers must have an AKC Junior Handler number.

### **RIBBON AWARDS (both days)**

Highest Combined Score will be a total of the scores from Advanced B and Excellent B. High Combined Triple Score will be a total of the scores from Advanced B, Excellent B, and Master. In case of a tie, the dog with the fastest combined time of runs will win. If there continues to be a tie, a run-off will be run by the Rally Judge on the final course set-up for the trial per judging schedule at the completion of the Rally judging.

### AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or event secretary, and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death, or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.)

**AKC FEES: A recording fee of \$4.50, included in entry fee, will be required for every entry in each trial in any Licensed or Member Rally Club Trial. All Recording Fees and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules Chap. 11, Sec. 2).**

BITCHES IN SEASON - Entry fee less \$5.00 will be refunded to entrants of bitches in these rally trials upon written certification by a licensed veterinarian to the effect that the bitch in question is in season on the day of the trial. Notification must be received by the Secretary before 8:00 A.M. on the trial day.

TRANSFERS after the closing date will be allowed if the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

Requests for transfers in Rally must be submitted in writing to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

**CRATE SPACE is provided in designated areas. Please provide your own rug or blanket to put under your crates and chairs to protect the matting.**

No dogs will be allowed in the building overnight.

CLEAN UP after your dog! Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems there is a violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal containers are available at various locations around the show grounds.
