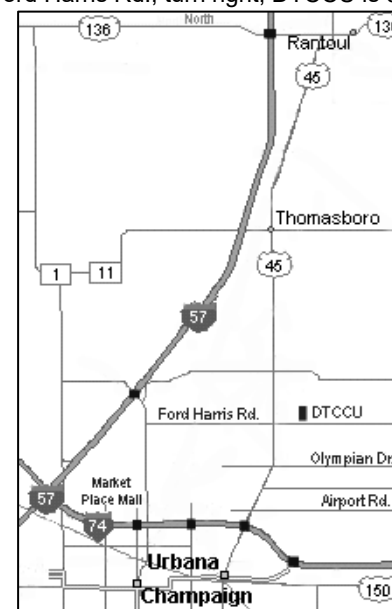

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The **safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is **expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The DTCCU and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The DTCCU reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the DTCCU or any official thereof.

Safe Environment. The AKC is committed to creating a safe and respectful sport environment for all. If you need to talk to someone or need help, please call 1-800-656-HOPE (National Sexual Assault Hotline) or text HOME to 741-741 for free, confidential services from trained crisis counselors.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, flood, extreme weather conditions, act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Entry fees will be refunded in full if a written request (mail/email) is received by the trial secretary on or before trial closing date.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. The club will refund the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for this reason; a written request must be received by the trial secretary no later than ½ hour before the start of the first class of the day. A dated letter or bill (including handler or dog name; personal details should be redacted from bill) from a doctor or veterinarian indicating the issue may be required for a \$10/run refund for a handler or dog that is unable to compete due to illness or injury; a written request must be received by the trial secretary ½ hour before the start of judging on Saturday.

CATALOGS

Catalogs may be pre-ordered on your entry form for \$8; \$10 if purchased at trial. Running orders will be emailed to exhibitors.

No entries will be accepted by phone or fax. No hand deliveries during the first 24 hours after entries have opened. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry form changes, additions, corrections, and cancellations **MUST** be received in writing prior to the closing date. Email changes are welcomed. Inquiries may be directed to the trial secretary, sbuetti@gmail.com

The trial secretary will confirm receipt of all emails – if you do not receive a reply within a few days, your email was not received. The trial secretary is not responsible for emails not received.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on entry forms. The secretary is not responsible for correcting errors on forms. Please read your confirmation emails. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. **Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry and the Club will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Envelopes containing entries for more than the 10 dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

Email confirmation of entries will be sent after an entry is received and entered into the database. Please make sure your email address is legible and that the secretary's email address is not blocked. Final confirmations with the judging schedule & preliminary running order will be emailed/mailed after the closing date.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

The warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class – this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present, **all** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before its first run of the weekend*. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs should be physically sound. Blind dogs shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2, Registration & Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under 4 months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Master/Exc. classes are NOT offered at these trials.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Green flat qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs receiving a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to 1st-4th place dogs in each height division in each class, except T2B with a rosette for 1st place. Dogs must qualify to place. Prizes must be claimed at the trial. New Title rosettes will be available to teams finishing a title.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles meet the specifications in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes are indoors in an air-conditioned building on Comfort-King ½" Agility Matting over concrete. Ring is 62.5' x 105' with walls on 3 sides.

SITE INFORMATION

LIMITED crating space is available inside the building. Unentered dogs will not be allowed to crate in the building. Unlimited crating space is available outside – be prepared to provide your own shade/cooling as none is available.

Please place a mat under your crate to protect the matting. No ex-pens unless you have a very large dog or have multiple dogs in one pen. The trial committee reserves the right to ask exhibitor cooperation to conserve space to fit everyone inside. Crates may be left in the building overnight; DTCCU will not be responsible for any lost/damaged items. No dogs may be left overnight.

No food is available for purchase on site, but there are various restaurants and fast food places within a short driving distance (S on Rt. 45; 2nd & 3rd exits W off of I-74).

AKC regs require that dogs must be on leash, crated, or otherwise under physical control at all times on the trial grounds when not competing or at the practice jump. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog. Any exhibitor failing to do so will be excused without benefit of refund.

VOLUNTEERS

A great trial depends on great volunteers – we couldn't do it without you! Workers, who are not DTCCU club members, will receive \$2 coupons; snacks, and drinks will be available.

If you've never volunteered before but would like to, there are several jobs that are easy to learn and get you close to the action in the ring.

Saturday and Sunday Signup will be sent in confirmation email.

Recent Permanent AKC Changes:

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes and/or Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Additionally, a dog may be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

For Exhibition Only (FEO) – Offered at these trials for all classes.

FEO is offered in all classes and is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter classes prior to the closing date, pay class entry fees, and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Catalog as part of the results. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level offered. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely cannot be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Fix and Go On (FNG) allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. FNG is not pre-entered and may be used in any class. You do not need to tell the judge are using FNG.

Leashes. When running the course, **leashes** may be worn or put in pockets. If the dog grabs the leash while running, this will be scored as "E".

The **one-judge requirement** to title in the Novice through Excellent level agility classes has been made permanent.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior to the Owner?
